

Authorship Criteria at MedPulse Spectrum

1. **Guiding Principles:** MedPulse Spectrum adheres to the standards set by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) and the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) in handling research manuscripts from submission to publication.
2. **Authorship Criteria:** At MedPulse Spectrum, authorship is considered when the following four criteria set by the ICMJE are met:
 - a. **Substantial Involvement:** Contributions should include conception, design, data collection, analysis, and interpretation.
 - b. **Manuscript Contribution:** Authors should actively contribute to drafting or critically revising the manuscript's intellectual content.
 - c. **Final Approval:** Participation in the final approval process of the manuscript ready for publication is essential.
 - d. **Shared Responsibility:** Authors must be willing to share responsibility for the entire research work, ensuring both integrity and accuracy.
3. **Accountability for Specific Aspects of Medical Research:** Authors must acknowledge responsibility for specific aspects of the medical research, ensuring thorough investigation and resolution of any questions related to accuracy or integrity.
4. **Review and Approval of Manuscript Submission:** Authors should agree to submit the manuscript to MedPulse Spectrum for publication and approve the final submitted version, in line with ICMJE and COPE guidelines.
5. **Leadership in Project Coordination:** Authors are expected to actively participate in project coordination, demonstrating leadership to ensure proper acknowledgment of all contributors who meet authorship criteria.
6. **Acknowledgment of Funding Sources in Healthcare Research:** Authors must disclose financial support and provide a clear acknowledgment of the role of funding sources in supporting the healthcare research, adhering to ICMJE and COPE standards.
7. **Disclosure of Potential Conflicts of Interest in Medical Contexts:** Full disclosure of any potential conflicts of interest that could have influenced the medical research, or its outcomes is required.
8. **Agreement to Authorship Order Reflecting Contribution Levels:** Authors should acknowledge and agree regarding the order of authorship, which should accurately reflect the level of contribution of each author to the medical research, aligning with ICMJE and COPE guidelines.
9. **Adherence to Ethical Standards in Medical Research:** Authors must provide assurance that the medical research is conducted in accordance with ethical standards, including obtaining necessary approvals and informed consent, consistent with ICMJE and COPE principles.
10. **Active Participation in Manuscript Preparation for MedPulse Spectrum:** Authors are expected to actively participate in the preparation of the manuscript and its submission, ensuring alignment with MedPulse Spectrum's specific guidelines for publication.
11. **Recognition Beyond Authorship:** MedPulse Spectrum acknowledges valuable assistance from contributors who fall short of authorship criteria, such as:
 - Support in acquiring research funds
 - Supervision without active participation

- Contributions to study design, manuscript review, writing assistance, proofreading, and editorial support.
 - Assistance in finding cases, laboratory procedures, or statistical analysis.
12. **Protocols on Author List Amendments:** MedPulse Spectrum strictly prohibits any additions, alterations, or deletions to the submitted author list post-submission.
 13. **Declaration of Contributions:** Authors must submit a detailed individual contribution description during the initial submission, using the Author's Undertaking and Copyright Transfer form available for download on MedPulse Spectrum's website.
 14. **Role of the Corresponding Author:** Communication during the submission and peer-review process is primarily with the designated corresponding author, who plays a pivotal role in cooperation, addressing data requests, and providing additional information.
 15. **Deceased Authors Notification:** To indicate authors who passed away before publication, MedPulse Spectrum recommends using double hashtag (**) after their names. Include details about their death in a dedicated footnote.
